Uniform Policy

St John's Primary School uniform consists of:

- **Green or white shirts or polo shirts.** We all like the green school polo shirts, but recognise that they are more expensive. However, we would like every child to own at least one green shirt. We have sourced a cheaper option through the uniform suppliers. We also have a healthy stock of second hand uniform.
- **Navy sweatshirts or cardigans** with or without the school logo
- **Grey trousers, skirts, shorts or pinafore dresses.** Shorts must be school shorts. Skirts must be of a suitable length (ie knee length)
- **Plain, dark tights. Plain dark or white socks.**
- **Blue and white check dresses** for the summer months
- **Dark school shoes** (black, brown or navy) during the winter months. Smart black, brown or navy boots may be worn in very cold or wet weather
- **Sensible sandals**, if desired, for the summer months. Plain and flat with straps around the foot and heel to hold them firmly in place

What is unacceptable?

- Hot pants. City shorts (ie knee length) can be worn but they must be grey.
- Other footwear. Shoes must be sensible and dark. For example, 'Ugg' style boots and football or fashion trainers are not acceptable. Children spend many hours in these shoes so they should be well fitted and support their growing feet.
- Sandals must be suitable for running about in. They must have well fitting straps over the foot and around the heel. 'Walking' type sandals are ideal and are available widely at a variety of prices. Flip flops, crocs, heels and party sandals are not appropriate or safe.
- Black or blue trousers, skirts or shorts
- Leggings

Uniform ordering and purchasing is managed through the PTA.
