

JACS is an after-school care scheme, open to children who attend St John's. The group has been running successfully since it was set up in 1995. We try to provide a relaxed and friendly atmosphere with a variety of activities to suit all.

Opening Times

From 3.00 to 5.30, except when school closes early, when we run from the end of the school day for 2¹/₂ hours.

Safeguarding

Safeguarding and protecting children is very important to us. JACS ensures all staff know their responsibilities for safeguarding.

Absence

If for any reason your child is absent from school, please inform the school office who will in turn inform us. However, if your child will not be attending JACS for any other reason, we need a note from the parent/guardian, which should be put in the JACS box in the school office.

Sickness

A child with an infectious or contagious illness should not attend JACS. If a child is obviously unwell, the parent/guardian will be contacted and asked to take him or her home.

Emergency

A qualified first-aider is present at all sessions. However, in the event of an emergency, an ambulance would be called and the child taken to hospital, if necessary. Every effort would be made to contact the parent/guardian.
