Children and young people wanted to take part in research

Can your child help us find out how the brain processes numbers?

Is your child aged **6, 10 or 14 years old**? Or starting their **AS Levels** in September?

If they are **right-handed**, a **fluent English speaker** they could **participate!***

The study involves a **safe brain scan** using a Magnetic Resonance scanner (1 ½ hours) and several **puzzles and games** (3 hours). These sessions will be **repeated in 18 to 24 months'** time.

Your child will receive a voucher to say **thank you** for taking part. We will reimburse reasonable travel expenses. Parents of under 16 year olds will be compensated for their time.

* **Exclusion criteria apply:** Children who have a learning difficulty (e.g. dyslexia, dyscalculia), psychiatric disorder or contraindications to MRI cannot take part.
