Young Art Oxford Competition

Today the children have been told about an exciting opportunity to have their artwork exhibited at The Ashmolean in Oxford. Next week they will be working on an entry for this year's Young Art Oxford 2018 competition, which is held in aid of Cancer Research UK. All the money raised is used for research into finding cures for childhood cancers and improving existing treatments. The theme for this year's exhibition is "JOURNEYS".

There are four age categories with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize in each. A panel of judges (which include Korky Paul, Sarah Simblet, Mark Haddon and Suzie Moxley) will select a certain number of paintings from each school to be exhibited on the Thursday 10th May, Friday 11th May and Saturday 12th May at the Ashmolean Museum. The exhibition is a wonderful way to encourage children's artistic talents and is also a great fundraiser. The children's artwork will be for sale at the exhibition in aid of Cancer Research UK and postcards/canvases can be ordered of each of the selected pictures. The more pictures St John's Primary School submit, the greater representation we will have in the exhibition.

As one of the aims of the competition is to raise money for Cancer Research UK, a £2 fee is required for each picture entered (only one entry per child). All the money raised goes directly to Cancer Research UK (Registered Charity No. 089464).

We hope you will want to enter your child's picture. Please tape a £2 coin on the strip below and return it to your child's class teacher by **Friday 9th February** if they would like to enter their artwork.

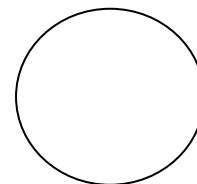
