Dear parents,

Thank you for supporting our 'Walk to School Week' this week. The children have really enjoyed completing the activities in their booklets and collecting stickers on their class charts. We held a briefing for parents on Wednesday evening to talk through our recent Ofsted report. Thank you to those of you who came. I was pleased to be able to talk through the journey since our last inspection and have attached the slides for those who were unable to make it.

On the first Tuesday after half term we will be visited by the NSPCC who are delivering their important 'Speak Out, Stay Safe' assemblies to all of the children.
